



Supplemental instructions for use of the BXpanded KBXBD4 Backhoe Dolly with the BX22 or BX23 tractor equipped with the BT600 back hoe.

The geometry of the BT600 is slightly different than the geometry of the BT601 and BT602 used on later models of the Kubota BX series tractors. This difference requires a slightly different procedure from that described in the Owner's Information supplied with the product or in our demonstration videos.

The procedure is the same except when the BH is "rocking off" of the tractor, the BH might contact the rear fenders. To avoid this, rock the BH backward by raising the main boom. Stop before the BH contacts the fender. Use the BH outriggers to lift the BH slightly to clear the bottom hooks. Move the tractor forward just enough to clear the BH. Raise the boom to allow the BH to rock fully to the rear onto the dolly. Raise the outriggers and secure with a strap, etc. to prevent leak down over time. Turn off the engine and unhook the hydraulic lines.

Re-installation is the reverse of the removal.
